EDEN PROJECT ANGLESEA WATER ELEMENT



Housed below the water level, a magical immersion into mysterious worlds of water awaits, acting as a portal to neighbouring freshwater ecologies as well as below the waves at Point Addis. It is driven by the act of purification: of the lake's chemistry and our culture's philosophy. Rising from the lake, a wondrous centrepiece that is the inner sanctum of the project, a living monument to deep-time and a statement of intent to humanity's central role as planetary stewards.
